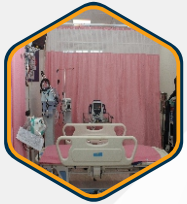


4) BACHELORS OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIST (PARAMEDIC)

Bachelors of Emergency Medical Technologist (PARAMEDIC) is a 4-year programme including three years of academics and one year of internship which trains the candidates in emergency medical techniques to become first responders to all kind of medical emergencies and save patients with various medical emergencies within and outside the hospital.



5) BACHELOR OF OPTOMETRY (B.OPTOM)

Bachelor of Optometry (B.OPTOM) is a five-year programme including four years of academics and one year of internship designed to help students learn the basics of vision care. They are trained to prescribe eyeglasses or contact lenses and diagnose various ophthalmic conditions.



6) BACHELOR OF DIALYSIS THERAPY TECHNOLOGY (B.DTT)

Bachelor of Dialysis Therapy Technology (B.DTT) is a 4-year programme including three years of academics and one year of internship that is designed to train students in Peritoneal dialysis, Plasma pheresis and Renal Replacement Therapy. Candidates are trained in wholesome renal care for patients with chronic kidney diseases and thereby provide a supportive role in hospitals and dialysis treatment centres.

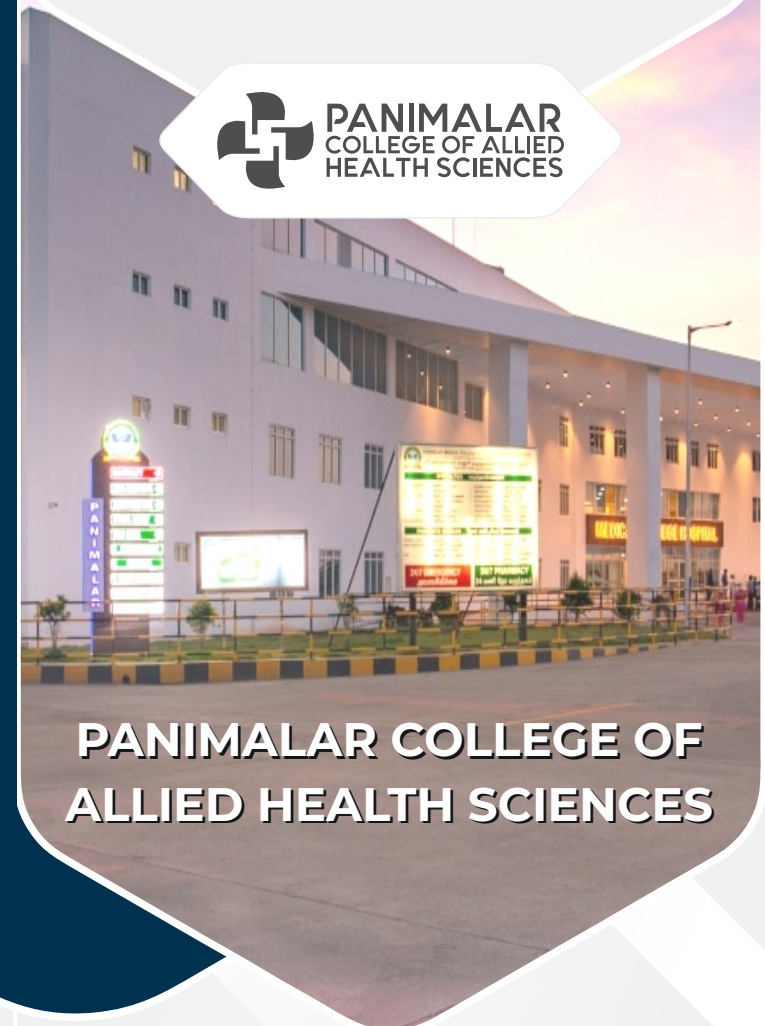

3) BACHELOR OF ANAESTHESIA AND OPERATION THEATRE TECHNOLOGY (B.AOTT)
